On October 16th, 2022, Bergen County Academies High School hosted the Joe Holbrook Memorial Math Competition and invited many students living in Bergen County to attend. These students, ranging from 4th to 8th grade, participated in a series of 40 math questions. The event lasted for several hours, and by the end, the top ten students from each grade were given rewards.

This huge event was planned months in advance. In June, the

Math Team captains of the school sent out emails to math students to encourage them to contribute problems for the contest. Many of these problems were to be used for the actual contest. Then, about a month before the event, captains gathered nearly a hundred high school volunteers, who stayed at the school from 8AM to 4PM. These students were given different roles for the day, such as standing outside to help out the parents, proctoring the contests, and grading the results. And to thank

the volunteers for spending more than eight hours at school on a Saturday, they were each given a free 2022 JHMMC t-shirt!

Apart from the contest, there were so many exciting events happening around the competition. As a reward, the participants each received free pens and 2-by-2 Rubik's cubes. After receiving these awards, the students were escorted to the school auditorium, where Po Shen Loh, the national coach of the United States' International Math Olympiad team, gave a talk to the students on finding their talents in math. Throughout the discussion, he stressed the importance of never quitting, and encouraged the students to keep trying in math. No matter how hard a problem might be, there are always infinitely many ways to come up with a creative way to find the solution. He also emphasized learning from the problems that students

got wrong, because it is a great way of making sure that they do not repeat the same mistake next time at a bigger competition. Although the talk was only about an hour long, Po Shen Loh gave out many helpful tips regarding math and also important life lessons.

At the end of the talk, the top ten winners of each grade were announced, and the students had a chance to celebrate their great accomplishments with their family. Although not everyone won the awards, this event was a great motivation for them to keep studying and continue to grow in mathematics.

After the contest was over, it was clear that the event was a great success. With many volunteers preparing for the competition months before, the 2022 JHMMC was surely a fun and successful event that will be remembered for years to come.

## 26 Years of Blood Donation

On December 19, 2022, 100 blood certificates were donated. These donations added up to 410 certificate donations in total for 26 years. Certificate donations to the "Leukemia and Pediatric Cancer Association" will change into packs of blood. Certificate donations are needed because countless people need other people's blood to live. There are three types of blood donations which are whole blood (donating whole blood), plasma (taking only a few parts), and platelets (taking only a few parts).

Blood donation is one of the hardest volunteering jobs to do. People are allowed to donate blood twice in one month, which is at most 24 donations in 1 year. Moreover, many people cannot donate

blood because of their physical conditions. For instance, in Korea, a person must be older than 16 years and younger than 69 years old. Also, men must be at least 50 kg, and women must be at least 45 kg to donate blood.

Blood donor Young Jin Yu has donated 410 blood certificates in 26 years. Young Jin Yu said, "When I was in the first year of college, I saw a blood donation bus by accident. It was my first time donating blood. I kept doing it because I thought it might be useful when my mother was in the hospital. By donating blood, I can check my body and feel responsible for taking care of my body. We are not able to live by ourselves in this society. We need to help others and cooperate. In

that way, I think blood donation is similar. Numerous people might get help with my donated blood. To everyone who tries to donate blood, it is very important to check their body condition before donating... My goal is to donate 900 certificates to "Leukemia and Pediatric Cancer Association."

There are countless reasons why people should donate their blood if they can. Donating helps other people who need blood and gives them time to think about their body condition and take responsibility for themselves. Since there are many types of blood donations, try donating blood and helping many people that may need it.

Not only has the city added new hotels, such as the Palazzo, but they have included new fine restaurants in many hotels, which are open to all. Vegas' high roller, which is a Ferris wheel that stands 550 feet in the sky and rotates for 30 minutes, is one of the most famous attractions. It is a great place to spend time with your family and friends, drinking and enjoying the view of Vegas with its busy lights. Directly next to this high roller is a zipline called the Fly LINQ Zipline, run by the LINQ hotel. Standing 12

stories tall, this zipline is a necessary experience to fulfill your Vegas trip. "The ride wasn't that scary, but going up to the actual platform to ride it was" stated Aron Jung.

The city of Las Vegas is known for its entertainment, both inside the city and just outside. Inside the city, there are many famous attractions, such as Circus Circus, fountain shows, and the Mirage volcano. Circus Circus is an amusement park popular with kids and includes many rides and even an arcade! Although it is not quite as famous as it used to be, Circus Circus will remain an

iconic park for all Vegas fans. The fountain in front of the hotel Bellagio, presents the audience with fountain shows lasting up to three minutes. These waterwork shows change each and every time, leaving the audience with little boredom, as it even plays music to match the water. Mirage Volcano is a volcanic structure that entertains guests with fire shows, which can only be found at 10 P.M.

Outside the city, you can find the seven magic mountains and the Valley of Fire. The Seven Magic Mountains are located right before you enter the city of Las Vegas, presenting seven beautiful art pieces, consisting of many large colored boulders stacked upon each other. This site is extremely popular amongst tourists, having around 90 viewers at every moment of the day. This piece of art is one of the largest land-based art works in the United States. Each individual pillar of rocks containing from three to six boulders, standing around 33 feet tall, shows the "continuities and solidarities between human and nature," as stated in the metal information stand in front. The Valley of Fire makes for a great day trip; containing over 46,000 acres of

land, it holds around fourteen different sites and viewpoints, with five famous spots. These are the beehives, Atlatl Rock, Elephant Rock, Mouse's Tank, and the White Domes. The beehives are a sandstone formation in the shape of beehives, from the conical shape to the holes and spots in the rocks. Atlatl Rock is a large boulder with stairs leading to a display of petroglyphs, while to the right of this rock, there are a number of petroglyphs on the walls. Elephant Rock is a large arch formation that is in the shape of an elephant; although it lacks a bit of detail, with imagination, it is possible to be seen as an elephant. Mouse's tank is a trail that leads to a hole in the floor with water collected from rainfall, along this hike, there are multiple "home-looking" rocks and indents in the walls, along with petroglyphs. The White Domes hold the most famous trail in the Valley of Fire due to its challenges, but the result is extremely rewarding. Climbing boulders and walking through a narrow slot canyon, this trail is a loop back to where you started.

Overall, if you are looking for a city that has a bit of everything, Las Vegas is the place you should visit.

## How to Keep Your Pets Warm During Winter

Although not every part of the world turns icy cold when winter arrives, some parts do. This signifies times when weather refashions itself to drop temperatures violently and shower snow from the clouds. In South Korea, the season showed up rather abruptly, with extra-cold temperatures this year. Sudden differences in weather can leave household pets in exposure, healthwise. While even gradual adaptation may be difficult for these small animals, winter unfolding quickly can easily tear down their immune systems if precautions are not followed.

Some may believe that pets would not need to be kept particularly warm for many reasons. For example, assuming a furred animal would thrive without extra heat-

ing as they already own fur is incorrect. Furred animals can chill quite swiftly, especially if younger or small. One could readily imagine that fish or amphibians would not require extra warmth since they are both cold-blooded animals; nevertheless, because they are cold-blooded, altering body temperature is difficult for these animals.

Generally, pets are divided into

five categories: fish, insects, reptiles and amphibians, birds, and the most common—mammals. For smaller pets, including fish, insects, reptiles and amphibians, and sometimes birds, heating pads will work fine since these pets are usually kept indoors. Pet heating pads use electricity as the heat source and have differing levels of heat that can be altered according to the conditions. Placing these heating pads under pets' enclosures can help warm the pets up.

Pet mammals can be categorized further, but typical pet examples involve dogs, cats, and many rodents, such as guinea pigs, hamsters, gerbils, and chinchillas. Dogs are one of the most active pets, and most require outdoor activity. A simple way to moder-

ate the freeze of the outdoors is to dress dogs in clothing. There are wide varieties to choose from, like dog shirts or coats, to prevent body heat from escaping and dog socks to stop their paws from freezing. As for indoor dogs and cats, using the same sources people utilize for heat: rugs, blankets, heaters, or even body heat, can all work. Because most rodents use some type of bedding as nesting material, the addition of pet rodents' bedding provides cover and warmth. Supplemental hideouts or heating pads are also great.

It is always crucial to maintain pets' health as the climate modifies, taking care to warm them to a comfortable temperature. Keep pets happy and safe at the same time by following methods to warm them!
