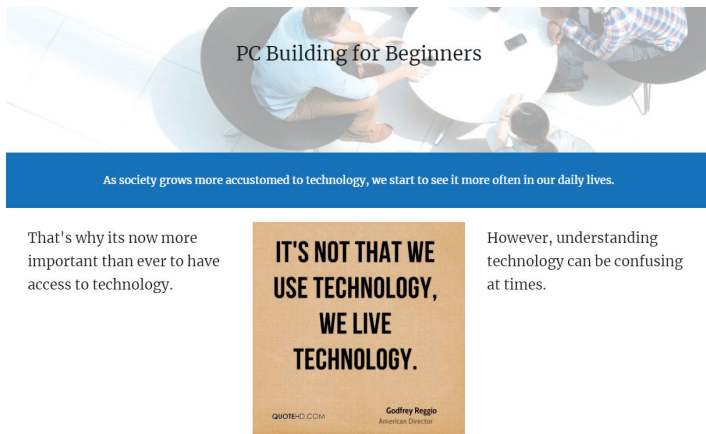


2021 Korea Daily High School Summer Internship Concludes

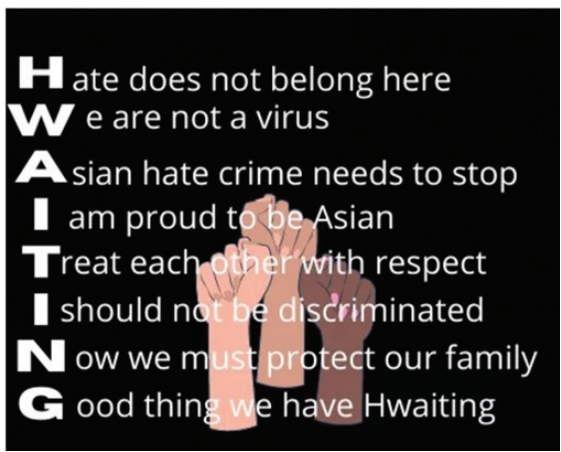

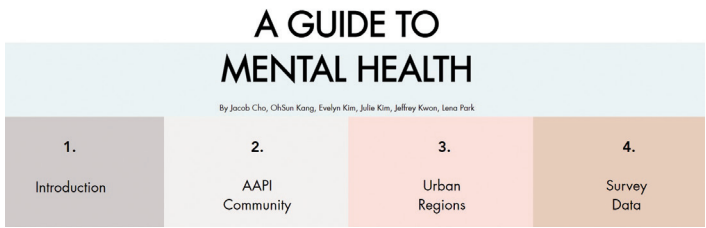

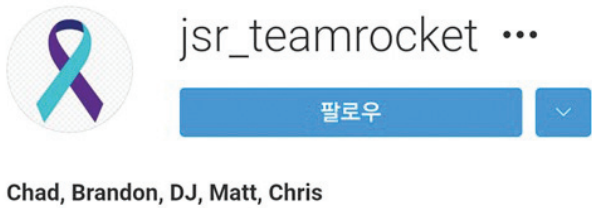
